

## **Precautions To Prevent Wildlife From Coming Into the Camp**

- Never store your food in your tent or outside your cabin. The best place for your food is either inside a locked vehicle or inside a locked cabin.
- Do not leave your coolers unattended in the camp. Wild animals are curious and will eat almost anything they can get. Again, the best place for your coolers is inside a locked vehicle or your cabin.
- If you go fishing and are lucky, clean your fish outside the camp ground and do not leave the remains on the ground for the animals to find. This only encourages them to search the camp for more food.
- Carter Creek is a pet-friendly area but never leave your pet alone on a camping trip. Also, when walking with your pet ensure you have them on a leash so if you come across wildlife your pet will not be able to antagonize them.
- Garbage cans should never be left unattended. Ensure they are tightly sealed and placed in a locked vehicle or cabin.
- A dumpster is located near the entrance of the camp for disposal of your garbage.
