

CARTER CREEK CAMP

1. CARTER CREEK CAMP:

- a. Is located on the north slope of the beautiful Uintah Mountains primitive area. The snowcapped peaks viewed from highway 150 are the brightest in the state.
- b. Is approximately 105 miles from Hill AFB, with an elevation of approximately 9000 feet. Take I-84/I-80 East up Weber Canyon to Evanston, Wyoming (exit 5), and Highway 150 South to the Bear River Service Station (mile mark 49). Go 1/10 of a mile and turn left (East); proceed approximately 4 miles to Carter Creek Camp, which is on the right side of the road (look for the sign). The road leading to Carter Creek Camp is gravel.
- c. There is a map showing approximately where Carter Creek Camp is on the back of this packet.
- d. Carter Creek Camp is open seven days a week from 1 July to 15 October. **(Weather permitting) (ALL WATER IN THE CAMP WILL BE SHUT OFF OCTOBER 1ST.)**
- e. Linen, sheets and towels not provided. Must bring your own!

2. FACILITY DESCRIPTION:

- a. There are 5 one-bedroom cabins(cabin #1, #2, #4, #5, #6):
 - i. Refrigerator, stove, sink with hot and cold running water, microwave, heater, dining room table with five chairs, one double bed, one single bed and one set of bunk beds. **MAXIMUM OF 5 PEOPLE PER CABIN, NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- b. There is 1 two-bedroom cabin(cabin #3):
 - i. Refrigerator, stove, sink with hot and cold running water, microwave, heater, dining room table with seven chairs, two double beds, one single bed and one set of bunk beds. **MAXIMUM OF 7 PEOPLE PER CABIN, NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- c. There is 1 cabin with its own bathroom (large cabin #7):
 - i. Refrigerator, stove, sink with hot and cold running water, microwave, heater, dining room table with six chairs, shower, rest room, two double beds and one set of bunk beds. **MAXIMUM OF 6 PEOPLE PER CABIN, NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- d. There are 3- 27' trailers:
 - i. Stove, sink, refrigerator, microwave, self-contained, and a shower. **MAXIMUM OF 6 PEOPLE PER TRAILER, NO EXCEPTIONS!**
 - ii. **All trailers will be winterized and not available for rent after September 15th. No exceptions!**
- e. There are 4 RV pads that will hold up to a 30' camper. They have water and electric hookups but **NO** dump station.
- f. There are 3 tent sites that can hold **2** tents or **6** people at each.

- g. There is a bath house with showers and rest rooms (separate men’s and women’s) for all guests to use.
 - h. There are picnic tables and a central (community) fire pit that all guests are welcome to use.
 - i. There is an activity area with horseshoes and volleyball.
3. ELIGIBILITY:
- a. Open to all active duty military, retired military, and DOD civilians assigned to Hill AFB and other military bases. Customers may also bring guests **with** them.
4. FEES:

5 one-bedroom cabins	\$95.00 per night.
Two-bedroom cabin	\$119.00 per night.
Large cabin	\$149.00 per night.
4 RV pads	\$30.00 per night.
3 camp trailers	\$119.00 per night.
3 tent sites	\$25.00 per night.

New equipment rental fee schedule

ATV Rentals per day

\$100.00 per day (includes 1 tank of fuel and helmet.) **\$500.00 credit card deposit required upon pick-up of ATV.**

Beginning Jan. 1, 2023, Utah will require all OHV operators to complete the free Utah Off-Highway Vehicle Education Course. Operators under the age of 18 shall possess a youth OHV education certificate in order to operate an OHV on public land, road or trail. Operators 18 years of age or older may operate an OHV if they possess an approved adult OHV education certificate. The once-in-a-lifetime course is expected to take less than 30 minutes to complete.

To rent ATVs while at Carter Creek Camp, customers must show Carter Creek Staff Vehicle Education Course certification.

Canoe Rentals per day

\$20.00 per day (includes life jackets and paddles.) **\$100.00 credit card deposit required upon pick-up of canoes. Customer is responsible for securing and transporting of canoes to lakes.** Nearest lake is approximately 10 miles from the camp.

5. RESERVATIONS:

- a. Reservations are taken 2 months ahead of time beginning May 1st. 2 night minimum stay.

*Reservations may be made on the 1st business day of the month- Reservations for customers in line will be taken 1st.

- b. All reservations for Carter Creek Camp are taken at Outdoor Recreation, bldg 805, telephone number: 801-777-9666. **NOTE:** All reservations must be paid at the time of reservation. Reservations for customers in line will be taken 1st. 2 night minimum stay.
- c. Reservations may **NOT** be sold or given to another party. The person making the reservation **MUST** be in attendance the entire time of the stay. Reservation slip and I.D. card **must** be presented to the camp manager **prior** to occupying assigned cabin, trailer, RV pad, or tent site. Anyone failing to present proper I.D. and reservation slip will not be allowed to occupy the reserved area. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- d. Individuals making the reservation are responsible for the conduct of all members of their group.
- e. There are NO provisions for drop-in patrons at the camp. All reservations must be made in advance through Outdoor Recreation.

6. GENERAL INFORMATION:

- a. Check in time is 1400-2000 hours. Checkout time 1200 hours. Please check in and out with the camp host.
- b. Please inspect cabins upon arrival to ensure equipment is on hand and in good operating condition. Any discrepancies should be reported to the camp manager immediately.
- c. A Garbage Dumpster is located near the entrance of the camp for disposal of your garbage.
- d. Fires are permitted in designated areas only (wood, if available, will be provided by camp manager).
- e. Pets are allowed at the campsite only if kept on a leash. Owners are responsible for proper control of their pets and must clean up after them. Patrons are limited to two pets only!
- f. Utah state fish and game license is required for children 12 years and older. Fishing is available approximately 3 miles from Carter Creek.

- g. Cutting of trees and shrubs is prohibited: violators are subject to be fined by the US Forest Ranger.
- h. Riding of off-road motorcycles, three-wheelers, ATV's and bicycles in the camp is prohibited. Toy haulers and ATV trailers cannot be unloaded in camp. Unload before you get to camp and bring ATV's in the back way.
- Firearms, pellet guns, BB guns, paintball guns and sling shots **CAN NOT** be discharged or carried in the camp area at any time.
- i. Parents are responsible for their children at **ALL** times and will be held responsible for any damages caused. **THERE IS NO CHILD CARE AVAILABLE!**
- j. **NO** loud, abusive, or vulgar language will be tolerated at the camp.
- k. Guests violating any rules will be asked to leave with **NO** refund given!

***PATRONS SHOULD BRING THEIR OWN COOKING AND EATING UTENSILS, SOAP, TOWELS, FOOD, WARM CLOTHING, BEDDING, FISH GEAR, ICE FOR PERSONAL COOLERS AND USE, AND OTHER RECREATION OR PERSONAL EQUIPMENT NEEDED.**
